Fly KISS

Welcome on board

On November 7, Fly KISS took off from Clermont-Ferrand to serve 5 new destinations several times a week.

With more than five years experience providing tailored VIP flights and flights for major industrial groups, the ENHANCE AERO Group was at the heart of these new flights to Strasbourg, Lille, Nice, London and Brest.

Fly KISS used one of the Group's ERJ145 - a 50-seat jet - and its technical installations based at Clermont-Ferrand airport for nearly 10 years.

Despite the 15,000 passengers transported in 6 months, and some 1,200 flights made, Fly KISS decided - despite the great potential and interest of the routes offered - to redeploy and to abandon for the moment the connections to Clermont Ferrand. The President of the group specifies: "The balance sheet at the end of the first six months reveals a growing interest and confirms the expected objectives. However we are at 10 points of the fill rate which would allow us balance. We are still economically the only actor to support this great project to the benefit of the opening up of our region, the Auvergne and Clermont-Ferrand. In this context, we remain open to any exchange with local partners who would like to accompany us. I would also like to reiterate my thanks to the Vice-President of the Region, Mr Brice HORTEFEUX, for his readiness, his interest and the constant support he has shown".

Fly KISS does not hide the immense disappointment that accompanies this painful and detrimental decision for airport users and the economy of the region.

All the flights will be interrupted as of Saturday 27 May.
